### HELPING YOUNG FAMILIES

Through comprehensive in-residence social service, educational, and child development programs, we prepare homeless adolescent and young adult women with children for effective lives as parents and contributing members of society.

- Casework Counseling
- Housing Readiness and Placement
- On-site GED Program
- Early Childhood Education Programs
- On-site Medical Clinic
- Parenting Skills Classes
- Women's Empowerment Program
- Collaborative Internship Program
- Recreational Activities

### LIVING OUT THE LATER YEARS WITH DIGNITY AND COMFORT

West End also provides dignified affordable permanent housing with supportive services to formerly homeless and low-income older adults. Quality of life is a primary focus as we work with our older residents, many of whom have experienced a renewed interest in life through contact and friendship with our staff and young families.

- Case Management and Entitlement Advocacy
- On-site Medical Services

### West End serves:

Young homeless mothers aged 18-24 with one or two children aged 7 and under. All families are referred by the New York City Department of Homeless Services.

Single low-income adults aged 55 years and older who are capable of independent living, are free of alcohol/drug dependence and are without severe psychiatric disorders. Applicants may be referred by the New York City Department of Homeless Services or community-based organizations.
